Update in Scotland

We had a bumper quarter in Scotland, allocating all available funding to ten great projects.

Shedden Park on the Scottish Borders received £42,000 towards a new skate park, meaning the enthusiastic skaters of Kelso and the surrounding villages will no longer need to travel 44 miles to Edinburgh to enjoy their thrills.

Queenzieburn (home of the Krankies) is a small mining village 14 miles from Glasgow. This quarter, Viridor Credits awarded £32,000 towards replacement play equipment in the local play park. The design will incorporate the needs of disabled children and the local kids are eagerly awaiting the completion of the works in March 2017.

Kirsty Provan, mother to one of the excited children, said "without funding from Viridor Credits, we would never have been able to complete the park".
